“The Culture” Guns in America

This documentary sheds light on gun culture in America focusing on urban and suburban neighborhoods. It breaks down & investigates the environment, results, and motives of our gun culture.

“The Culture” follows a variety of people with contrasting opinions over the issue of violence in our country and how to attack the problem with reasonable solutions. It chronicles street outreach workers, conservatives, and victims of gun violence. “The Culture” is the first documentary that truly gives unbiased look of guns in our country.

“Step Up” Fatherhood in America
RT 55min

This documentary reveals the effects of absentee fathers on both the child(ren) and the family as a whole. It follows the stories of several fathers who are either struggling to fulfill their obligations as fathers, and/or facing their feelings regarding their own absent fathers. The film’s goal is to draw awareness to the negative impacts left on a child’s psyche when the father is not a part of his or her life.

The documentary features candid, in-depth interviews from individuals from all walks of life, including a popular radio disc jockey, a street outreach manager (Conan Harris) – even a group of single mothers who provide real insight into the dynamics of the family circle, particularly when the father is absent.

Created by the award-winning production team of Noube Productions, comprised of Noube Rateau (Founder), Hakim Hill, and William Medero, Step Up is the latest of the team’s projects. Noube Productions focuses on documentaries regarding the human spirit.

**President / Director**

Noubé Rateau was born December 12, 1988 and was brought into television at the age of thirteen. After four years of broadcasting division one high school sports Noubé Rateau continued on the collegiate level doing NCAA tournament games.

Noubé's broadcasting has brought honors from the Curry Associated Press and the Bears Sports Network. As a former producer for a local cable station, Noubé's work has earned national attention from the Alliance for Community Media winning first place honors for best magazine format show. Noubé has received honors from the South Shore Leadership Parent Committee, African Festival Market Committee, and the South Shore Haitians United for Progress for his service to the community of Brockton.

Noubé also serves as the Director of Communications for the office of Mayor Bill Carpenter in the City of Brockton serving a community of 100,000, the 6th largest city in Massachusetts.

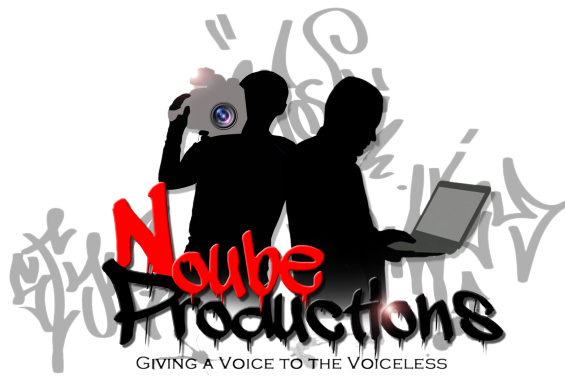
**Vice President /Producer
